BYO linen or can be supplied for a small fee, No stove but an electric frying pan, microwave and 2 induction hotplates with all appropriate cookware provided. You can BYO BBQ or use the community electric BBQ in the park just across the road.

Looking straight across the road to beautiful Kurrimine Beach and boat ramp makes this an ideal spot! The Owner lives in the Unit next door and shared tandem parking under cover for one vehicle. The Council overflow car park is next to the property and is ideal for off street parking for the boat.
